2016 Championship Show Class Schedule:

- **Thursday - 9/22/16** - Classes begin at 7 a.m.. The last class of the day will be Class 24 Jr Egg & Spoon-Pleasure Horse. Classes 3 thru 8 and classes 18 thru 22 will be run simultaneously.
- **Friday - 9/23/16** - Classes begin at 7 a.m. with class 25 Int. Western Pleasure. The last class of the day will be Class 41 Tandem Bareback. Horsemanship classes will be run simultaneously.
- **Saturday - 9/24/16** - Classes begin at 7 a.m. with class Classes 42 and 43 (Sr. Speed Dash and Int. Speed Dash) running simultaneously. Class 42 thru Class 60 will be run simultaneously. The last class of the day will be Class 60 Sr. Pennant.
- **Sunday - 9/25/16** - Classes begin at 7 a.m. with Class 61 Sr 50+ Jumping Figure Eight. The royalty coronation will be held after Class 66 PW Jumping Figure Eight. The last class of the day will be Class 71 Sr. Egg & Spoon – Game Horse.
- **Monday - 9/26/16** - Classes begin at 7 a.m. with Class 72 Int. Barrels. The last class of the day is Class 79 Sr 50+ Barrels.

Qualifications:

- Qualification dates for the 2016 WSCA Championship Show are from 8/24/2015 thru 8/21/2016. You must have qualified between those dates to be eligible to enter.

NOTE: Entries postmarked after 8/22/2016 must pay “post entry fee rates”. NO EXCEPTIONS!

- Riders must be a member in good standing of a WSCA saddle club as of May 31, 2016, and their name must appear on the WSCA Membership List.

*Riders must have placed either first or second at a WSCA judged horse show in a WSCA qualifying class within the qualifying dates listed above.

- Riders must ride in their appropriate age class, and correct pony size corresponding to age. Class and age divisions are to be determined as of January 1, 2016. Class and age divisions are:

Pet Pony	48” and under pony, rider 10 years and under
Pony	54” and under pony, rider 13 years and under
Pee Wee	Horse over 54”, rider 10 years and under
Junior Rider	Horse over 54”, rider 11 to 13 years
Intermediate Rider	Rider 14 to 17 years
Senior Rider	Rider 18 to 34 years
Sr+ Rider	Rider 35 to 49 years
Sr 50+ Rider	Rider 50 years and over

- A rider and/or horse may enter and ride in only ONE 4-in-line barrels team.
- A Non-Stock Type Western Pleasure class is open to horses such as Arabians, Morgans, and Saddlebred-type horses that are **lighter in build** than the stock horse breeds. They also should move with an obvious degree of carriage.
- All Ponies **MUST** be measured at the Champ Show prior to their class. Ponies must show in their appropriate size and age appropriate class.
- **A COPY OF EACH HORSE’S COGGINS PAPERS ARE REQUIRED TO BE SENT WITH THE ENTRIES. Bring the original Coggins paper along to the show to be available to the show veterinarian upon request.**
- Refunds for entry fees will be given only in the case of an illness or injury to the horse or rider. A doctor’s letter, or a letter from your veterinarian stating the reason you cannot participate, **MUST** be submitted to the show office. Refunds for any other reason will not be given. **No refunds will be given for stalls.**
